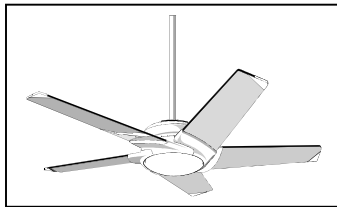

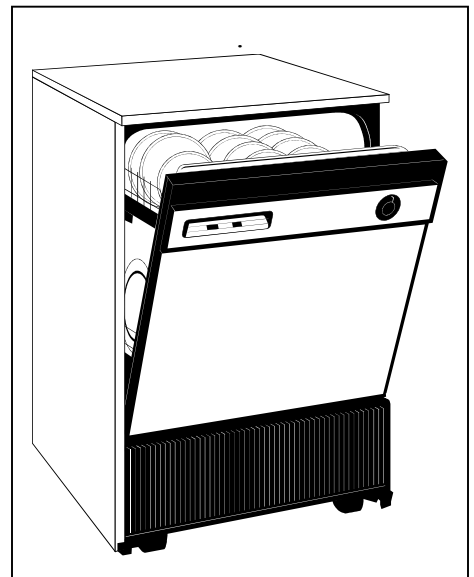
The Ceiling Fan Wobble

The wobble of a ceiling fan could be due to the blades either being off balance, out of track or warped. Other factors could be air turbulence from a sloped ceiling. You can check the balance of the blades by clipping a clothespin to the blade halfway between the tip and the blade iron on the leading edge; by turning the fan on low you can see if the weight of the clothespin is reducing the wobble . Try each blade and replace the clothespin with lead-weighted tape.



Dishwasher Stain Removal

A black coating that builds up on the sides and bottom of the dishwasher are a sign that you have hard water. To remove this black coating use acetic acid (from the local hardware store) and mix one part acetic acid to four parts water. If the black is heavy, increase the mixture to two parts acetic acid and two parts water.. Using rubber gloves and goggles, wash the inside of the dishwasher. After washing place two tablespoons of baking soda in to the empty dishwasher and run it through a complete cycle.



GRILLING THE SAFE WAY

By following a few simple, steps you can have a fun and healthy barbeque. Marinate all meats and vegetables in the refrigerator, not on the counter. Grill all partially cooked meats right away and be sure to cook to a high enough temperature to kill bacteria. Wash all plates, utensils and surfaces that contacted raw meat.

Always cook meat to medium or well done to prevent any food contamination. Grill leaner meats, as fat tends to burn and char, and this burned substance is known to cause cancer.

Avoid using any chemical fluids, as they are harmful to the environment and add small amounts of chemical into the cooked foods. Try electric or gas grills or use a chimney starter.
